Padre's Portion.... Archbishop Vlazny is coming to visit and celebrate with us at Sacred Heart. The Archbishop accepted our invitation to come and celebrate Confirmation with our teens and adults. What a blessing. Last time we were visited by an Archbishop was when Archbishop Vlazny came and celebrated the Sacrament 8 years ago. Please mark May 4th on your calendar -- the 4:30 p.m. Saturday Vigil Mass. Following the Mass we will have an all parish lasagna dinner in the Fellowship Hall. Please plan to come and support our newly confirmed.

What do you remember about your Confirmation? Mine was huge in numbers. 2 classrooms full of 7th graders. The big fear was that the Archbishop would ask me a question. Fortunately he didn't. It was big and impersonal. We all wore red robes. My sponsor was my first cousin's husband, a nice guy, but I hardly knew him. I'm praying (and please join me) that the teens in our group have and will continue to encounter Jesus in all the coming days. "Come, Holy Spirit."

My goal as I've prepped these wonderful young people to see Jesus in a new way. It is difficult for those who grew up with Jesus and know him somewhat intimately to reshape their understanding of who Jesus is. He is so much more than the snotty-nosed child that ran around the village, disturbed temple services, regaled elders with his precociousness and escaped notice of his parents for three days. "Where did this man get all this?" the people at the synagogue ask. "Is he not the carpenter"? Those are all the images of Jesus I had I confess as a child. He did become the Savior, Lord and friend as I've grown to know and love Him now. That's what I want for our Confirmandi. Jesus is our friend. He walks by us and beside us and behind us always. We can talk to him at any time anywhere. I really like the preface of Consecration which says, "and gives (the host) (the cup) to His friends." At that profound moment we are reminded we are His friends.

February really is another month of Mary. Here are the feast days that relate to her presence in our lives: Purification of Mary - February 2 - This celebration recalls an old tradition that a woman who gives birth to a son must participate in a ritual 40 days after the birth. St. Josephine Bakhita – February 8 – Patron of Sudan. "Be good, love the Lord, pray for those who do not know Him. What a great grace it is to know God!" St. Scholastica – February 10. She is the patron saint of Benedictine nuns/sisters, education, and ill children, and she is invoked against storms and rain. Twin sister of St. Benedict Our Lady of Lourdes – February 11: phenomenal place to visit and pray with thousands. This day celebrates Mary's appearance to St. Bernadette and her declaration:"I am the Immaculate Conception."

Please pray a decade of the Rosary a day for peace.
