**Padre's Portion....** Thank you for the warm welcome and greeting for the representatives from Dandelion House in Milwaukie. Here are some of the key thoughts that really touched my heart. I hope they touched yours too.

"Every other god enslaves. Our God is a God of liberation; every other God enslaves."

"This is what made Jesus so upset in today's reading...He is against a religion that enslaves, rather than liberates."

"Stop making my Father's house a marketplace," he yells. Stop turning my Father's house, the Temple of the Living God of Liberation, into a marketplace, a place for you to profit off the taxes, and labor and misery of the poor."

"To believe in God means to struggle against idols. One must always say two things: in which God one believes, and in which idol one does not believe...What is our Yes, and what is our No?"

"If we are called to remember Jesus in this bread that is broken and the blood which is poured out whose actual blood is spirit we must say Yes to Jesus in the sacrament and to say No to the blasphemy of war."

"Our Yes {Dandelion House) is to the Earth... Our Yes is to prayer...We say no to the madness of war and nuclear weapons...We say No to modernizing our nuclear weapons and We say Yes to feeding and housing our neighbors."

"This Lenten Season, I invite you to join us at Dandelion House, to pray, to serve, to protest. To say Yes, and to say No."

Whether you agree with Fumi or not, he was definitely thought provoking and challenging. Lots for me to take to prayer and discuss with the Lord.
