One reason was COVID but it was something my Mom really enjoyed and after she died I lost interest in attending. So this past 1st Friday of Lent, Pastoral Council was in charge of it so I led the Stations in the Church. We use an English translation that has been used here at Sacred Heart ever since I came. However, I was really moved by many of the passages I led the people in. Here's a few that I invite you to reflect upon and maybe even come to choose to join us.

"Lord Jesus Christ, help us to see in the sufferings and shortcomings of our lives a share in Your Cross; strengthen and console us in the belief that we bear all things in union with You, who have upon Yourself even our guilt."

"A faithful friend is a sturdy shelter; he who finds one finds a treasure. A faithful friend is beyond price, no sum can balance his worth. A faithful friend is a life-saving remedy."

"Though he was harshly treated he submitted and opened not his mouth; like a lamb led to the slaughter or a sheep before the shearers, he was silent and uttered no cry."

I lost track that I wanted to share with you from an article about "101 things to do for Lent." So here's some more. 1. On Friday's eat plant based protein; 2. Don't look at your cell phone when in the presence of others; 3. Arrive early; don't be late; 4. Ask a Senior Citizen for a story about his/her life; 5. Read a poem and ponder it; 6. Make a visit to a Church once a week; 7. No late night snacks for the rest of Lent; 8. Pray this week for someone who annoys you; 9. Pray the Morning Offering (remember it?) 10. Let yourself be bored; sit and be quiet.
