

Padre's Portion –

Thank you again for all your prayers and support as I had the pace maker procedure done. It worked as all of you, who have one, told me. It's amazing. Now it's exercise my legs so I can get my balance stronger. I wanted to share a phenomenon with you that happened to me. I was in the waiting room watching the clock slowly tick by. I was supposed to be at 1:30p.m. but there was the possibility of 3:30 p.m. Then the Doctor came in to see me and as he left he told me he is seeing me in about 20 minutes. The hairs on my arms and on the back of my neck stood up, I knew the Holy Spirit was blowing in the wind, and I was going to be okay. I felt back on the "cloud of prayers" that were sustaining me throughout all the days. Thank you.

Also, I just want to re-quote 3 Pope Francis statements during his historic trip to Canada two weeks ago:

"Dear Indigenous Brothers and Sisters, I have come here as a pilgrim also to say to you how precious you are to me and to the Church. May the Lord helps us move forward in the healing process towards an ever more healthy and renewed future."

"Our own efforts aren't enough to achieve healing and reconciliation: we need God's grace. We need the Spirit's quiet and powerful wisdom. May he fulfill the expectations of our hearts. May he take us by the hand and enable us to walk together."

"How precious is the most genuine intimacy and sense of community among the aborigines! How important it is to carefully cultivate the bond between young and old, and to maintain a healthy and harmonious relationship with all creation!"

All of these quotes (and more) speak to each of us too; not just the indigenous people of Canada. Read them as he was speaking to you. They are beautiful.

I love our Community gatherings. I missed the last one because I thought for sure a day after surgery I'd be able to come. God had a different plan. This week's Ministry Spotlight: Greeters

Greeters are the face of Sacred Heart Parish for each person who enters the church. They reflect the welcoming nature of Catholicism – an acceptance of those who come to know Jesus. In many ways their ministry is the simplest, but it also is among the most personally important. Being greeted by a parishioner reminds you that church is a community, not a group of individuals who happen to be worshipping in the same place. It is that sense of community that builds a parish family and sustains it through good times and bad. For visitors, the Greeter invites them in to, at least temporarily, become part of the community.

In addition to welcoming people, Greeters normally select those who will bring up the bread, wine and collection at the Presentation of the Gifts.
