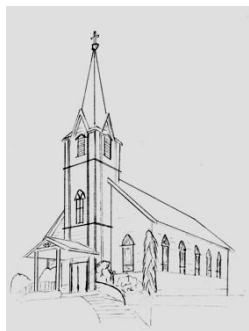

Padre's Portion: In a way our Thanksgiving celebration really kicks off the whole Advent/Christmas season for me. As a result with Thanksgiving so early this year, we get an extra Sunday before the first Sunday of Advent. So today, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. It is always the final feast of our liturgical year. And if we just reflect back on this year, each of us have our own memories, some powerful and positive, some filled with pain and wonder.
