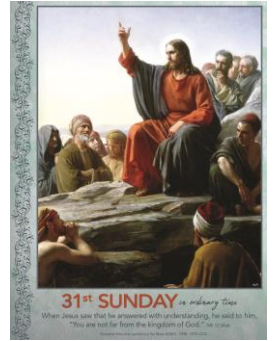

Padre's Portion The Gospel this last week on Thursday, our Holyday of Opportunity for the Feast of All Saints, is a great one for us to hear once again especially as we enter November and December. These months are filled with great celebrations but also a time for us to reflect on the blessings we have and our call to help others through our giving.

The Beatitudes invite us to be disciples of Jesus. The beatitudes present a new way of life, not centered on personal gain, but on self-sacrificing love, a love that witnesses to the gracious and compassionate presence of Jesus who liberates and redeems. Jesus raises up crucial attitudes toward life and our relationships as the way of the holy: being poor, so we know the only source of power is God; the solidarity and compassion of the sorrowing; the gentle who do not bring violence; the true longing for a holy justice; the plenitude and abundance of mercy; the singleness of heart that acknowledges the one desire that informs all our other desires – to know Jesus; the active stand for restoration, reconciliation and harmony. If we live faithfully these values, then surely we will disrupt the status quo, we will bring upon us the wrath of others, as Jesus did. But we have cause to rejoice, to be glad, for it is in our fidelity to these values of the reign of God that we share in God's very life.

This month we also remember the women and men in our Christian community who have died and share in the new life of Jesus. They join our Litany of the Saints throughout this month as our contemporary saints. Please place your names in the Memory Book, and all the names we will remember at every Mass.

Speaking of saints! Thanks to Priscilla Holman and all her Saints who helped organize the Harvest Festival last Saturday night. It was a huge success for those who attended. Many of our young ones dressed up in the costume finery. But I believe for me (besides the corn dogs!) the best part was watching all the adults playing the games as they allowed themselves to be children again. It was wonderful! This is heaven. We, the Children of God, playing and celebrating being together in love.

As I've watched the news coverage of the tragedy at the "Tree of Life" Synagogue in Pittsburgh, I had a devastating thought: What if we lost 11 of our senior pillars aged 54-97 years old within minutes? My heart is so heavy with sadness thinking what this community -- this city -- has lost. More questions than answers. But I have to hold on to Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace. 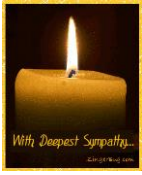
