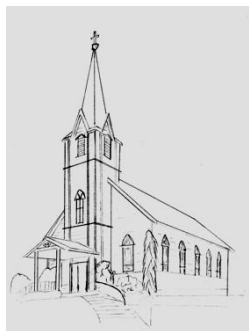

## **March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**

**Padre's Portion....** I'm hoping most of us got "marked" for the Kingdom and wore those ashes with a humble pride! It's not to show off; it's to acknowledge we belong to Jesus who on the Cross marked us as His for life. I hope that every one of you got asked at least once, "What's that black smudge on your forehead?" Or someone to say to you, "You're face is dirty." And that it is the mark of the Kingdom of heaven and we are headed there!

Try to attend Mass once or twice a week (Wednesday through Friday) as a special preparation for Holy Week and the great feast of Easter. Come to Stations of the Cross every Friday night then spend some time with each other afterwards at the Soup Supper. Pick up a Word Among Us and take it home to spend a few minutes during your day reflecting on the Scriptures of the day. "Black Books" are in the back of the Church. Join one of the many Catholic websites that offer daily reflections (Word on Fire, Dynamic Catholic, Fr. Richard Rohr, and the Jesuits to name a few). We only have 2 catechumens preparing for Easter. Invite one of them out for a cup of coffee or lunch and share your faith and enthusiasm for them as new members of our faith community. Bottom line, do something that will enrich you! Lent is such a gift to us Catholics because it really does call us to "Repent" – to return to our roots and our relationship with God whom we will all meet one day face to face. We just want to make sure we recognize Him!

In the words of Pope Francis:  
Fast from hurting words and say kind words.  
Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude.  
Fast from anger and be filled with patience.  
Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.  
Fast from worries and have trust in God.  
Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.  
Fast from pressures and be prayerful.  
Fast from selfishness and be compassionate to others.  
Fast from grudges and be reconciled.  
Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.
