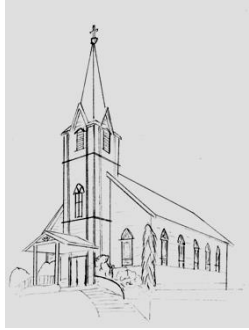

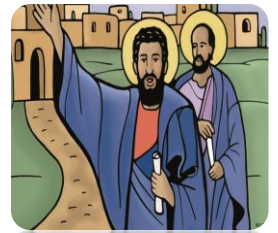

Padre's Portion... On this 4th of July weekend readings, the line that really strikes me is, "Behold, I have given you the power to tread upon serpents and scorpions and upon the full force of the enemy and nothing will harm you." The freedom we have is in knowing that our God is far beyond our imaginations and we are to bring His Kingdom here and now by being conduits of God's grace. That's what Jesus is telling the 72 in the Gospel: "Don't take anything with you of the world." Nothing is to impede the message that the Kingdom of God is at hand. God's Kingdom is a Kingdom of love, forgiveness, compassion, support, care, nurturing and so on. We are to live in the freedom that we are "an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and [let God] do the rest." This is the freedom we all can celebrate not only this weekend but every day of our lives.

And the last week of June was a week of celebration for me and for the entire parish. I celebrated 25 years of priesthood. Where did the time go? And then I begin to count, but I count by the endless number of people who have invited me to be a part of their lives. People in Southern Oregon, Holy Family, and all of you here at Sacred Heart.
