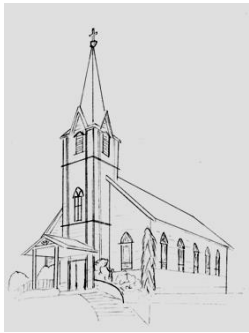

Padre's Portion.... I so wish I would have been able to announce to you Pope Francis' interviews this past weekend on CBS and "60 minutes." With the abilities through social media platforms, it can be viewed and shared easier. You might want to download the "You Tube" App if you don't have it. That's the first step. It's a free App. Then once you have it, you can "Search" or it will be on the first few lines of shows to preview as "Pope Francis the First" interview. There are 2. There's a 20 minute segment on 60 minutes on Sunday (May 19th) then the next night is the full hour interview.
