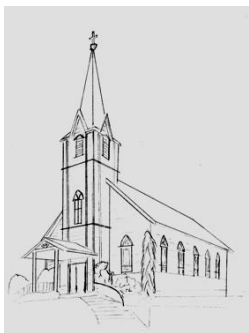

Padre's Portion.... This weekend is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. Many processions around the world will happen on this day to represent the importance of this Sacrament to us. However, I'd like to reflect on 4 Gospel stories that depict symbols to the Gospel events and Jesus and Communion. The first story brings to mind the six water jars referring to the miracle at Cana where Jesus changed water into wine. The second story is about the 5 loaves and two fish, referring to the miracle at Capernaum, where Jesus multiplied the loaves and fish and fed at least 5000 people. The third story is about the 13 people seated around the table of the Last Supper. Think about who was around the table. Saints and Sinners. Last but not least the fourth story is an Easter supper story. Jesus is at Emmaus with two of the disciples who recognized him finally in the breaking of the bread.

These 4 Stories are the heart of our Mass. Jesus changes water into wine and unleavened bread into His Body. He feeds all that are gathered at Church together (all over the world!) and we gather around the table – saints and sinners. And, hopefully, we ALL recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread. Those 4 simple stories capture the entire movement of the Lord's Supper. This happens every day around the world. It has been happening over 2000 years. Unfortunately so many people still don't get it, but we know YOU do!

So we're going to watch it starting June 5th at 12:45 p.m. in Fellowship Hall. An excellent movie that chronicles the struggles of a Roman soldier struggling with the Messiah. It has no easy answers. The movie is about 2 hours long so we will watch it in two parts: June 5th and 12th. Please join us.

One of the world’s top religious thinkers on migration will speak in Portland in June. **Registrants can attend in person or online.** Rev. Daniel Groody’s latest book, “A Theology of Migration: The Bodies of **Refugees** and the Body of Christ,” includes a **foreword from Pope Francis**. In a talk organized by Catholic Charities of Oregon, **Rev. Groody will speak at 7 p.m Wednesday, June 12, in Brian Doyle Auditorium at the University of Portland.**

“We don’t just need more statistics about migration,” says Father Groody.
“We need a new imagination.”

A professor and administrator at the University of Notre Dame, Rev. Groody has for decades traveled worldwide, met with migrants and deeply plumbed what migration means for life, society and faith. The priest not only examines the many instances of displacement and migration in Scripture -- including the holy family -- but reminds readers that Jesus made a migration from divinity to humanity. Also, **Jesus came to reconcile humanity, Rev. Groody says, positing that the Christian life overall is a migration from brokenness to oneness.**

Rev. Groody has served on the U.S. Catholic bishops’ committee on migration. **He advocates seeing the humanity of migrants and urges people to understand that all they have is a gift from the universe and not to be clasped too tightly.** That differs from a rising narrative in the United States, which frames migrants in general as threats.
