Padre's Portion.... This is the 2nd year of the U.S. Bishops Conference calling us to a Eucharistic Revival. I believe we have always been a Eucharistic Community -- In every Mass I try to remind us of the miracle that happens on the Altar every time we gather. The simple bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ -- which we then receive -- all the way to heaven. We will receive communion at every Mass. And why is this so, so important. Here at Mass all barriers are broken down by Jesus. And we come to Mass to not receive but to enter into Communion with Jesus and one another. No separation. We'll leave that outside the walls of the Church. Here it's Community. When we receive Jesus Christ, we receive ALL Jesus has done for us -- and all He asks us to be for one another: patient, compassionate, loving even if it's inconvenient.

I really like this quote that's come out of the multitude of articles about the Revival. "The Eucharistic Revival is a prayer, a hope, an opportunity for an encounter with Christ. We desire to grow closer to Christ; we trust that he desires this more than we do." Reflect on this beautiful statement. We come to Church because the Mass is a prayer, and we can always use "hope" and, of course, we all want to meet Christ. And we do in each other, in the Word, and at the Altar. Every single time we come. What a gift.
