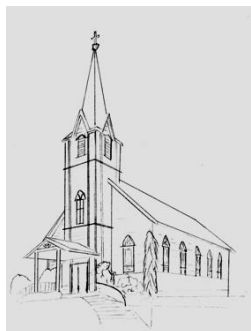

Padre's Portion.... We always seem to have interesting discussions in the Wednesday Scripture Class. It doesn't really go chapter and verse into Scripture, but I may suggest one of Jesus' quotes that sparks the discussion. These past 3 weeks have contained some real zingers. "The last shall be first", "We should live to serve rather than be served," "Whatever causes you to sin pluck it out, cut it off." I would like to encourage you to re-read the last 3 Sunday's Gospels. They are challenging. So in the course of our discussion, I had what I called a "Holy Spirit" moment. I mentioned we only had 7 more Sundays left in this Liturgical Year. What would they like to see included in the homily. What would the emphasis be?

Now I would really like this. I'm always telling each of you, you share and are anointed in the role of priest, prophet and King through your Baptism. So I extend the invitation to all of you. What would you like me to emphasize in the homily these last few Sundays before we begin anew with Advent? Here are some suggestions that have already come in from the Scripture group: kindness, empathy, compassion and many more. Add to the list. What do you think we maybe need to be reminded of as we enter the final weeks of the election season, prepare for Thanksgiving, Advent and Christmas. Think about it, pray about it, and send them to me. No names mentioned.
