Dear Parishioners,

Happy Feast of the baptism of the Lord! Besides encouraging you to worship the Lord and thank him for your baptism, I also want to express my apology for any miscommunication regarding the daily mass schedule. We posted a Christmas Mass Schedule both at the entrance of the church and on our website. This information was correct as was the bulletin for the Fourth Sunday of Advent on Dec. 21. They all had the correct information that there was no mass on Dec. 31. However, a later bulletin on Dec. 28 for Holy Family had incorrect data listing a mass for Dec. 31. I regret this error and any inconvenience it caused.

This is an opportunity to teach. We usually celebrate daily masses on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at 11 am. However, if there is a vigil mass for a Solemnity or High Feast Day, we do not have a morning mass. For example, on Holy Thursday, there is no morning mass because you are encouraged to attend the vigil of the Evening mass of the Lord's supper. Another example was this past Christmas, which fell on a Thursday. The vigil mass for Christmas was at 4:30 pm on Dec. 24 on Wednesday. We did not have a morning mass on that day.

The best thing you can do is read the bulletin, read the website, and listen to announcements after mass. If there is any confusion, call the parish office. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
