FROM THE PASTOR

Liturgies during Lent

Come and join us to pray the rosary and attend mass during the weekdays of Lent. We celebrate daily mass on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday during Lent except during Holy Week. You will notice some small changes during daily mass. We will begin each mass with the penitential rite, in which we pray together the Confiteor, which begins "I confess to almighty God." Second, we do not sing alleluia during Lent but save this precious word until Easter season. So instead of alleluia, we'll sing "praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, king of endless glory." We will also sing the Lamb of God in Latin, the Agnus Dei. These prayers are not that difficult, and we will learn them together after a short time period. Finally, I will be using the two eucharistic prayers for reconciliation during masses of Lent. I would like us to reflect upon these two eucharistic prayers as food for meditation. I want to conclude this article by quoting from the beginning of the eucharistic prayer for reconciliation I: "you are indeed holy, O Lord, and from the world's beginning are ceaselessly at work, so that the human race may become holy, just as you yourself are holy." This prayer reminds us of God's essential nature: holiness. There is no sin in him; Jesus is like us in all things except sin. God the Father who is eternally holy is always working so that we may become holy, that we may become like him just as he himself is holy.
