Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, May 3rd, at the 10 am Mass, not only will we be celebrating the First Communion of Josephine and Lorenzo, but we will also be crowning Mary, as has been our tradition here at Sacred Heart at the beginning of May. As Mass begins, the children will process in with their flowers and place them in vases at the foot of the altar and then turn around and wait and watch as Josephine and Lorenzo (followed by Father Mike) come forward with the crown. Father Mike will bless the crown, and it will be handed off to Josephine's dad, who will climb the ladder and place it atop Mary. Then, Mass will proceed, and we will celebrate our wonderful First Communicants!

Next Sunday May 10th is Mother's day. Thank you, all mothers, for the great kindness and sacrifice you have made for your families. This is a bittersweet celebration for my family because our mother Christine Kueber passed away last Nov. 7. Now we have an earthly mother in heaven to intercede for me and my family. I also have a heavenly mother in Mary the mother of God and mother of the Church. She is our intercessor, model, and guide. I entrust my loved ones, including all the parishioners at Sacred Heart, to her motherly help and care.

In two weeks on May 17, we will celebrate the solemnity of the Ascension. At the end of his early life, Jesus ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father.
